

## ***Rules / Code of Conduct for the use of 29<sup>th</sup> Dublin Scout Den***

### **General (Applies to all groups)**

- Car park can only be used by leaders/coaches/instructors. Limitations apply.
- Children can only be on Scout property when suitably supervised by their section/clubs leaders/coaches/instructors.
- Each group is responsible for supplying their own First Aid Kit
- Non Scouting groups will have to supply a copy of their Public Liability insurance or a letter of Indemnity.

### **Outdoors (Applies to all groups)**

- Areas out of bounds
  - All rough ground
  - Pump house
  - Bank leading down the steps
- If open fires are used they must be done in the campfire circle
- All embers from open fires must be dowsed with water and disposed of appropriately
- All litter must be picked up
- Waste water must be strained and disposed of appropriately
- No holes or trenches to be dug
- When camping or running a loud activity a curfew of 12 midnight applies (we have neighbours)

### **Mainhall**

- If heaters and/or lights have no wire protection no footballs to be used in the den unless they are made of sponge
- Den should be swept and left tidy
- Fire area to be cleaned after use
- Chairs should be stacked against the wall
- Ensure all heaters are switched off on exit
- Ensure fire exits are unbolted on arrival and bolted on exit

### **Kitchen**

- All cutlery/cups etc., used must be washed, dried and put away
- Cooker to be kept clean
- No equipment from kitchen to be used on open fires
- Fridge to be emptied, switched off and left open when leaving
- No food to be left behind
- Bottle gas on cooker to be switched off each time you leave the Den
- Rubbish to be left where instructed
- Work surfaces and sink to be cleaned, wiped and dried
- All floors to be swept and mopped before leaving

## Toilets

- Must be kept clean and tidy
- Must be swept and mopped before leaving
- Each residential group is responsible for their own towels/soap/toilet rolls. Small supply available for other groups

## Leaders Room / Venture Room

- These rooms may only be used by members of the 29<sup>th</sup> Dublin for meeting, unless special arrangements have been made
- If used rooms are to be swept and mopped before leaving
- Do not obstruct wall heaters

## Changing rooms

- Boots are not allowed in the changing room
- Changing rooms to be swept and mopped before leaving
- Lost property must be taken of the premises by leader/coach/instructor on the night
- No access to the garage area
- If showers are used they must be mopped and cleaned
- Ensure all lights (including flood lights) are switched off when leaving
