Please Note:

When the scout is packing their rucksack, the rucksack must be lined with a plastic bin liner. No gear should be attached to the outside of the rucksack

Frequently Asked Questions

Should I pack my child's rucksack?

NO, if you pack the rucksack then in a lot of cases your child won't know what is in it or where it is. Certainly help them to pack, but it is better if they know how to do it themselves. Remember they will need to pack it themselves at the end of camp.

Can they bring electronics with them?

NO, we advise that no electronic devices (Phones, Gameboys, PSPs etc.) are brought because they could get broken or lost very easily.

Will boys and girls be sleeping separately?

YES, boys and girls always sleep in separate tents.

What are the toilet and shower facilities like?

The campsite has both toilets and showers, not quite like what the scouts will be used to at home but certainly sufficient.

How much money should we give them to bring?

We advise that all scouts are sent with the same amount of pocket money, the leaders will collect this at the start of the camp so that it can't get lost. They then are given an adequate amount each time that there is an opportunity to spend money. This year we are suggesting €20.

What do we do with medications?

If your child is on any medications at all the leaders need to know. Please put these in a zip lock bag with a piece of paper, which should give your child's name, the name of the medication and when and how often they need to take it. (All medications are kept in a locked box while on camp).
